THE MARSH CENTER

Named for longtime seminary professor and Air Force Reserve Chaplain (Maj. Gen) Gerald E. Marsh, the *Marsh Center for Chaplain Studies* continues to make a broad impact in the fastest growing field of ministry.

As of this year, the Center's book, *The Heart of a Chaplain*, has sold almost 3,000 soft cover copies and more than 1,100 copies in an e-book format. A second, more expansive edition, which will provide material for use in international chaplaincy settings, is in the works.

The Marsh Center's Director, Dr. Jim Browning, said the Center will also be focusing on curriculum development in the next year, as well as on the provision of webinars which address concepts such as moral injury and ministry to the aged with dementia.

The Marsh Center's advisory team is made up of more than 40 chaplaincy professionals from the military, health care, corporate, sports, and prison settings.

CHAPLAIN PROGRAM

CHAPLAINCY IS THE FASTEST-GROWING MINISTRY IN AMERICA.

B. H. Carroll offers a Master of Divinity in Chaplain Ministry, which recognizes the growing demand for ministry in specialized settings. God has called chaplains to reach people beyond the church and minister in military, hospital, prison, sports, and business settings. They have an invitation into people's lives who would not step into a church or meet with a pastor.

Due to this unique component, Carroll is adapting and expanding our educational efforts through chaplain-focused classes, webinars, seminars, and other opportunities. Carroll works to provide a refined academic preparation for vocational chaplaincy.

Through the Marsh Center for Chaplain Studies, Carroll is building collaborative relationships to enhance specialized courses that will prepare chaplaincy students for the needs of today as well as tomorrow.



COUNSELING PROGRAM

The B. H. Carroll Counseling Programs continue to grow and to graduate students into the counseling field. This past May, the counseling program celebrated 4 PhD graduates and 11 MA Counseling graduates. MA students continue to pass the National Counselor Exam at a high rate; currently, over 97% of graduates pass the exam. A recent graduate survey also found that a very high percentage of Carroll Counseling graduates are practicing in the field for which they were trained—most working in counseling centers, private practice, in ministry, or in community agencies. A program first for this past year was a graduate achieving the level of LPC-Supervisor, the highest level for a Texas LPC. Counseling Program faculty continue to speak at and host CEU conferences in various venues.

On January 26, 2024, the Counseling Program will host our third Equipping Ministry Leaders Conference, entitled: Abuse in the Community and in the Church: Assisting Counselors, Chaplains, and Ministers toward a Healing Response.



ACCESSIBLE

Courses are approximately 1/3 the cost of most seminaries; 88% of students graduate with no debt related to their degree.






ACHIEVABLE

HTEP PROGRAM

The B. H. Carroll Hispanic Theological Education Program (HTEP) began offering master-level courses in Spanish in August 2021. During that academic year, two students were enrolled, and five courses were offered. At present, four more students have been admitted and are actively enrolled. One student was admitted and is looking to enroll in January 2024. Three students are completing the Master of Arts in Religion, and four are enrolled in the Ministry Certificate. Two students are in Cuba, one in Mexico, and four in the United States. Twelve courses are being offered in Spanish during this academic year. HTEP's teaching faculty represent Mexico, Ecuador, Puerto Rico, Venezuela, Bolivia, and the United States. A promoter/recruiter was hired in January 2023.

As we look forward to an exciting future, we also want to celebrate the Lord's graciousness to Carroll Theological Seminary over the past twenty years.
